Membership in the American Legion as a Legionnaire is reserved exclusively for those who have served their country in time of war. The dates listed below are mandated by the United States Congress in the charter they have granted to the American Legion. You must have been an active member in one of the five branches of service (or the Merchant Marine for the period specified) and have an Honorable Discharge to be eligible to become a member. The dates are as follows:

- AUG 2, 1990—CESSATION OF HOSTILITIES • OPERATION DESERTSHIELD/DESERT STORM
- DEC. 20, 1989–JAN. 31, 1990 OPERATION JUST CAUSE/PANAMA
- AUG. 24, 1982-JUL. 31, 1984 LEBANON/GRENADA
- FEB. 28, 1961-MAY 7, 1975 VIETNAM WAR
- JUNE 25, 1950-JAN. 31, 1955 KOREAN WAR
- DEC. 7, 1941-DEC. 31, 1946 WORLD WAR II
- APR. 6, 1917-NOV. 11, 1918 WORLD WAR I
- U.S. MERCHANT MARINE DEC. 7, 1941-AUG. 15, 1945 Proof of service is normally established by

either a DD-214 showing your period of service, or an Active Duty ID card. The dues for this year are as follows; if you are 70 years old or older and have been a member of post 283 for 5 years or longer your dues are \$29.00, for all others dues are \$40.00. You may also mail your renewal to:

He organized celebrations as well as wrote seven books on U.S. history and the flag, after which he served in the United States Navy during WWI.
