You must have been an active member in one of the five branches of service (or the Merchant Marine for the period specified) and have an HONORABLE Discharge to be eligible to become a member. The dates are as follows:

- · JUNE 25, 1950 JAN 31, 1955 KOREAN WAR
- · DEC 7, 1941 DEC 31, 1946 WORLD WAR II
- · APR 6, 1917 NOV 11, 1918 WORLD WAR I
- · U.S. MERCHANT MARINE DEC 7, 1941 AUG 15, 1945

Proof of service is normally established by either a DD-214 showing your period of service, or an Active Duty ID card. The dues for the year are as follows; if you are 70 years old or older and have been a member of post 283 for a minimum of 5 years **consecutively** your dues are \$29.00. For everyone else dues are \$40.00.

### Post Service Officer Report

Greetings Legion members! I hope everyone has a Happy Thanksgiving! This month I would like to talk about Tricare Open Season and the new FEDVIP enrollments. I am going to provide some valuable information and remember I am always available for questions.

### TRICARE OPEN SEASON 12 NOV-10 DEC 2018:

**If you are happy with your plan: No action** is required during Open Season. As long as you remain eligible and continue to pay any applicable fees, you will stay enrolled and remain in the same plan going forward.

If you would like to make a change or enroll for the first time: You can choose between Prime, Select and direct care or enroll for the first time. TRICARE Standard is no longer a TRICARE option. For Standard-like benefits, you must enroll in Select

\*The National Defense Authorization Act for 2017 requires beneficiaries to enroll in a TRICARE plan.

#### FEDVIP ENROLLMENT 12 NOV-10 DEC 2018

On December 31, 2018, the Defense Health Agency's TRICARE Retiree Dental Program (TRDP) will end. However, as directed in the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) for Fiscal Year 2017, retired uniformed service members and their families, who were eligible for TRDP, will have the opportunity to enroll in the Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP). The first opportunity to enroll in FEDVIP will be during the next Federal Benefits Open Season, which runs from **November 12 through December 10, 2018** (ET), with coverage effective January 1, 2019. If you are currently enrolled in a TRDP plan, you will not be automatically enrolled in a FEDVIP plan for 2019. You must enroll during open season.

**FEDVIP Eligibility:** In general, retired uniformed service members and their families who were eligible for the TRICARE Retiree Dental Program (TRDP) are eligible for FEDVIP dental coverage and, if enrolled in a TRICARE health plan, FEDVIP vision coverage. In addition, family members of active duty uniformed service members who are enrolled in a TRICARE health plan are eligible for FEDVIP vision coverage. Coverage is effective January 1, 2019, if you enroll during the Federal Benefits Open Season.
